

THE BETTY SHUTTLEWORTH MEMORIAL BOWL

History

Betty's husband presented THE BETTY SHUTTLEWORTH MEMORIAL BOWL to the Ladies' Club in May 1978. It was his wish that the Rose Bowl should be USED for flowers. It was first played for on Wednesday 21st June, 1978 when it was won by Ada Aspinwall. Thereafter the Competition has taken place on a Wednesday in March close to Betty's birthday, the 23rd. Betty joined Coulsdon Court in the 1960's. She was an active and loyal member with a very lively and cheerful personality. She became treasurer in 1976 and during her year in office became seriously ill and had to give up the job. She died in March - April 1978. Shortly after her very good friend Helen Pope. They lived in the same road and Helen was particularly good to Betty during Betty's long illness. Betty's name appears several times on our Honours Boards.

The Memorial Bowl is 4³/₄ins. high with a plinth of 3¹/₄ins. The overall height is 8ins. The diameter of the Bowl to the outer rim is 9¹/₂ins, and the base 7¹/₂ins. The rim has a scalloped edge and a flower mesh. Trophy not to be engraved. The inscription on the side of the Bowl is:-
