THE JILL REEVES SALVER

(Captain v Secretary Match)

History

The Match is usually played in July and commemorates Jill Reeves' year as Captain. Jill lives locally and is now an Honorary Club Member and if available will present the salver on the day of the competition

Organisation

Voluntary contributions collected go to the charity of the Captain's choice.

(Committee decision - April 1996)

Format

All Handicaps – 18 Hole Match Play Competition. Entrants have to sign the list which is closed two weeks before the competition is due to be played.

The Captain and Secretary will lead the field. The two teams are drawn in handicap order, ie, the lowest handicap will go into the Captain's team and the next lowest into the Secretary's team and so on. If the two players have the same handicap, then the order is alphabetical. If there is an uneven number of players at the time of the draw, then the last person to put their name on the list will be designated a "reserve".

Any drawn player who is without a partner on the day may be teamed up with any other available drawn player, the one with the lowest handicap playing for the Captain's team. Should two drawn players mutually decide not to play on the day for an unacceptable reason, for example, poor weather conditions, their match shall be deemed null and void and not be counted as a half. This will ensure that the outcome of the overall result is not unfairly affected.

A Win is only given when one drawn player is without her own drawn playing partner and there is no other drawn player available to compete against.

PLEASE NOTE

Players who have not signed up for this competition can play in a stroke play competition at the end of the field.

Should there be a drawn member who has been awarded a **WIN**, then this result goes towards the Jill Reeves' Salver final result, and this particular player is then able to play at the back of the field with any other players who have not signed up for the competition.

Prizes

The leader of the winning team, ie, the Captain or the Secretary takes home the Salver and keeps it for one year. In the event of a draw, the Captain and the Secretary will hold the Salver for six months each.
