# SPRING AND AUTUMN MEETINGS

# **Organisation**

The Spring and Autumn Meetings shall each be played in April and September respectively each year, an extra-Medal round being played in the morning. A Greensomes Medal competition is played in the afternoon over 9 holes.

Members to choose their partners for the day.

Secretary will prepare time sheets for the morning and afternoon rounds.

### A.M. Extra-Medal Game

In the event of the morning Medal round being postponed for any reason, it shall take precedence over the Greensome competition.

Any member who fails to sign the signup sheet by the closing date of entry shall be ineligible to take a prize. However a member may put in an extra medal card, by signing the competition book without paying any entry money.

\* Members choose their own partner for the whole day.

Secretary will allocate times on time sheet ensuring those playing a.m. will go off in sequence in the afternoon and those playing both a.m. and p.m. will go off before those players playing in the a.m. round only. Play will be in twos and fours.

### P.M. GREENSOMES

Any member of the Club is eligible to play in the Greensome competition, provided she has signed the signup sheet by the closing date of entry.

1/4 combined handicap. (**not** rounded up or down).

### **AGGREGATE CUP**

The player who has the best aggregate nett score in the Spring and Autumn Medal rounds shall take the Aggregate Cup.

## **OFFICERS VASE**

This Cup is presented for the best Medal score attained by any qualifying officer - past or present playing in the morning round on the day of the Spring Meeting.
