

TEXAS SCRAMBLE

Format

Draw - Played in groups of 4, although a minimum of 3 may play. If two players remain after the draw then these two members will play a Stableford.

NB "That in competitions which are drawn and where a trophy is not being played for, members may be included after the closing date of entry, thus ensuring that as many members as possible are able to play". (AGM 1995)

If **4 members are in the team**, then take $\frac{1}{4}$ of the combined handicap.

If **3 members are in the team**, then take $\frac{1}{3}$ of the combined handicaps.

Take these strokes off your score at the end of the game.

If there are **4 players in a team**, then each member takes 4 drives with 2 drives remaining open.

All members drive off and then all players, **with the exception of the player whose drive is selected**, take shots from this best ball. The next shots are played by all players **except the player whose shot is selected** and so on until the ball is on the green. Then all players putt out.

If there are **3 players in a team**, then each member takes 6 drives and then everyone takes shots from the best ball, including the player whose ball is selected, until the ball is in the hole.

NB Do not putt out of turn if your ball is on the edge of the hole as a gross score is taken when the ball is in the hole.

Balls are placed on the fairways but dropped in the rough.

Prizes
